In his delightfully exhausting exhibition, *A Room Full Of Stuff I Made (And Collected)*, K. Nicol offers a stack of index cards with their lines carefully scraped off (and collected in bottles); a red button titled *Button I Pressed a Million Times*; a thousand bugs painstakingly glued onto a mat board; a shiny rectangle on the wall (*Magic Rectangle*), generated from using up a roll of Scotch Magic Tape; and, maybe most beautiful of all, four grids on paper, each made with one of the colours of a four-colour ballpoint pen.
